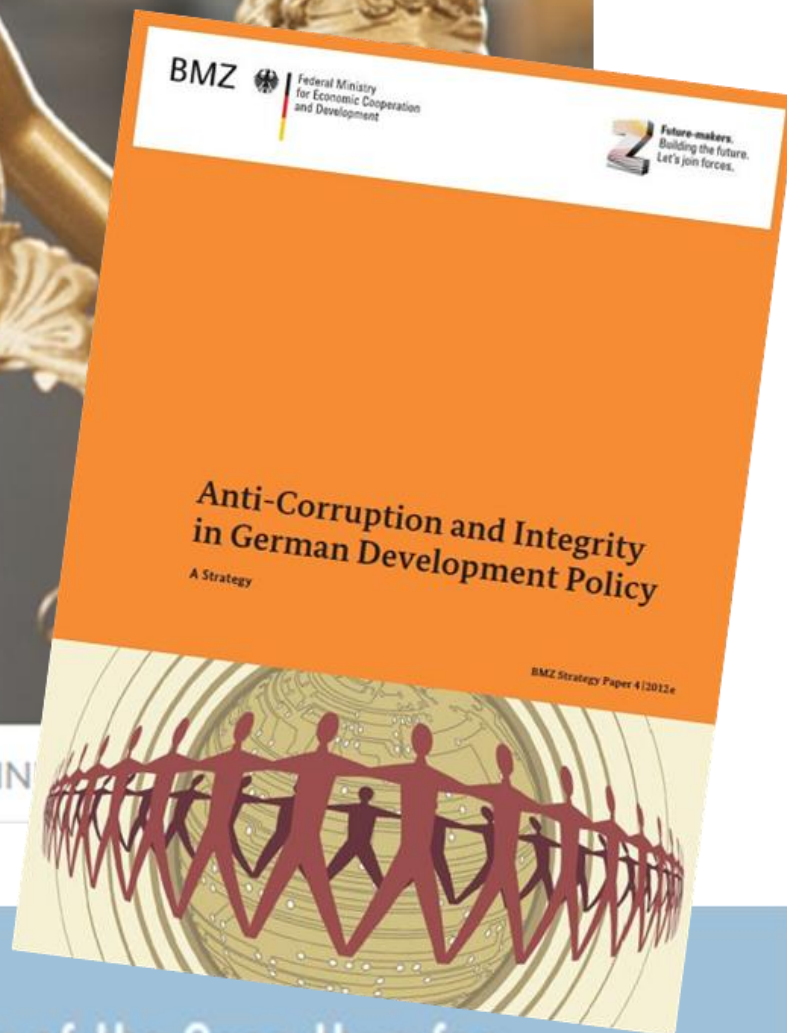
“I remember saying two sentences, and the interpreters would speak for 10 minutes in Russian, because the terminology did not exist.”
