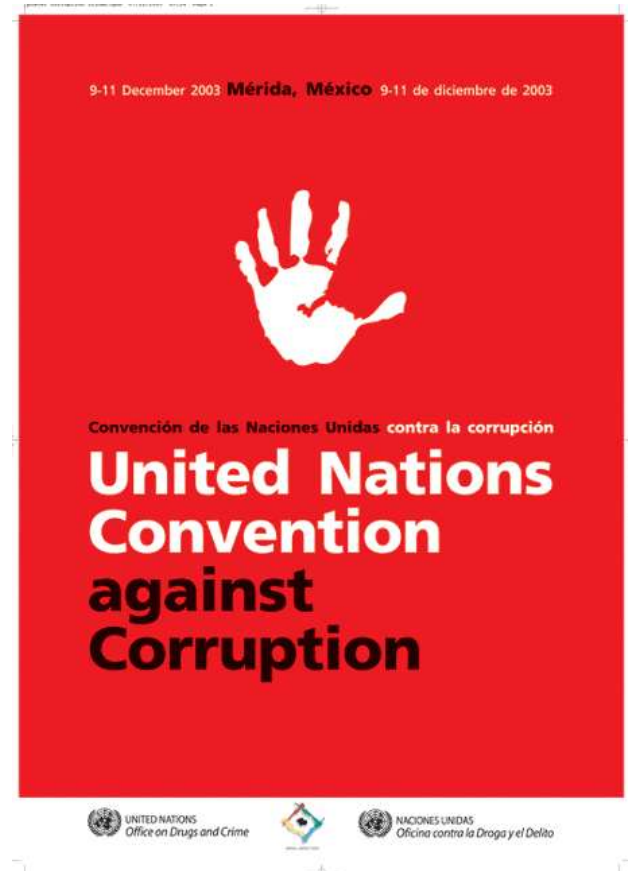

THE NEED FOR INTER-ORGANIZATIONAL COOPERATION

Reviewing fatigue

Overlap in review exercises (duplication)

Decreasing quality of responses to the self-assessment checklist.

Potential risk of contradictions

SOME SUGGESTIONS:

Dividide tasks. Each peer review has its strengths:

- The follow-up mechanisms of GRECO and WGB
- Technical assistance programs and global scope of the IRM

Self-assessment checklists.

Coordination in terms of country visits and time schedules.
