# 1. Encourage voluntary anti-corruption efforts

## Integrity Assessment

- » Assessing and disclosing the integrity levels at public institutions

### Assessment Model

- 1 External / Internal Integrity
- 2 Policy Customer Evaluation
- 3 Statistics on Corrupt Employees
- 4 Acts Undermining Credibility

- » **2018**: A survey of about 260,391 persons on corruption perception & experiences with 705 public institutions

### Winner of 2012 UN Public Service Awards

Technical assistance to Indonesia, Bhutan, Mongolia & Malaysia for the introduction of Integrity Assessment

Promotion of public participation & public-private partnership  
Reduction of corruption risks  
Promotion of a culture of integrity



### IMPROVE SPREAD

Improvement of integrity  
Dissemination of best practices



# 3. Corruption Risk Assessment

**Removing corruption-causing factors inherent in “bills” as well as existing laws and regulations**

Acts, Presidential decrees, Prime ministerial decrees, subordinate rules

**11 criteria in 4 assessment areas**  
*Compliance , Execution, Administrative Procedures & Corruption Control*

To improve reliability & predictability of policies

*Included in the legislative process*
