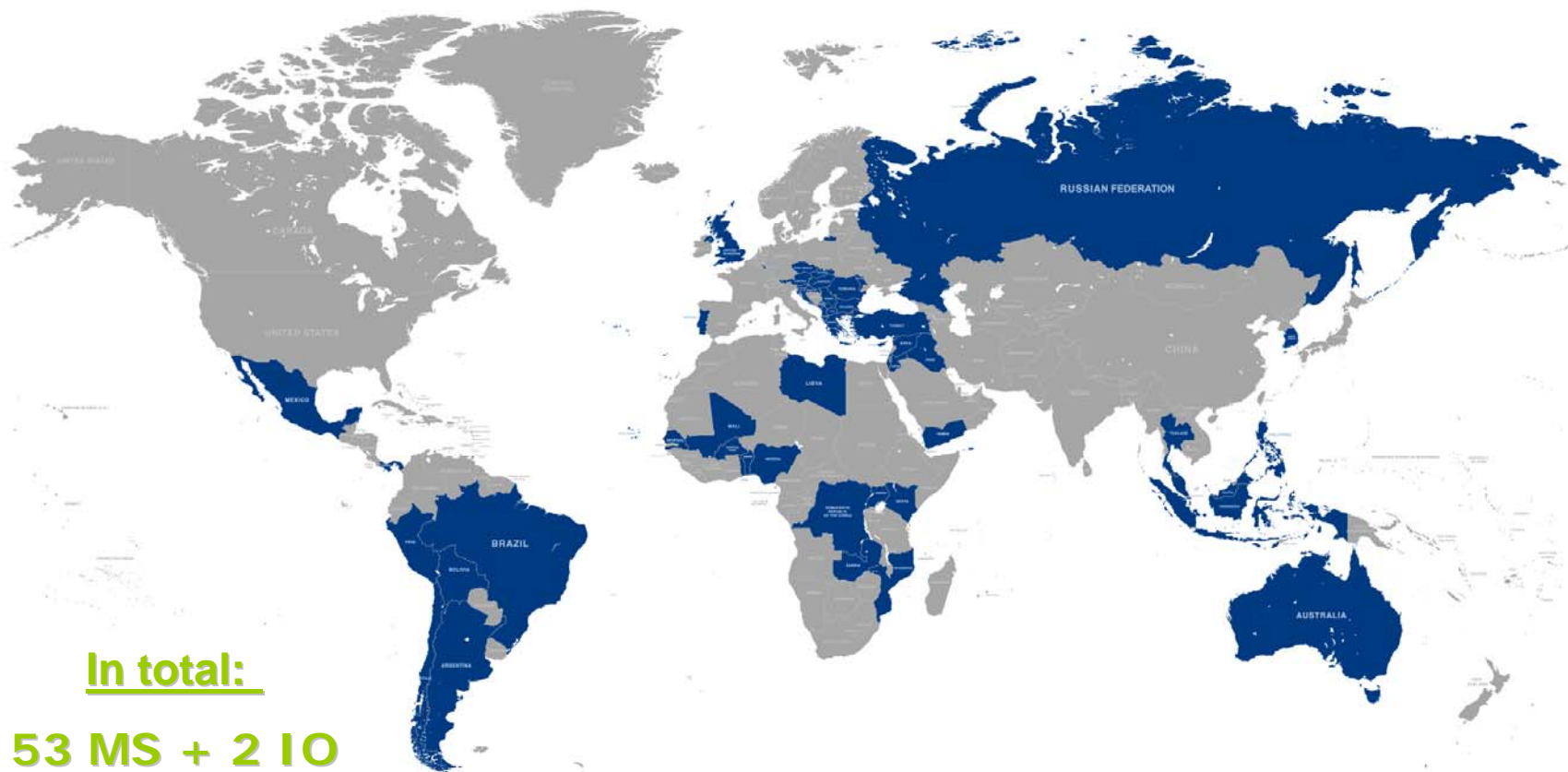

ARTICLE XI

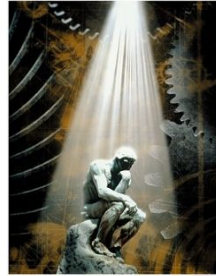

Concept, History and First Activity:



- International, inter-disciplinary, inter-sectoral and holistic post-graduate executive programme
- **Part-time, 8 modules: 12 days each, on-site / off-site training, real case scenarios**
- Starting with the academic year 2011/2012, around 50 students from all over the globe and all sectors will participate in a two-year on-site/off-site Master programme. They will have the opportunity to learn about different perspectives on corruption from some of the world's most imminent anti-corruption academics and experts, and scientifically engage in the (re)search for new solutions.
