with reference to the Secretary-General's Note CU 2011/45 of 18 March 2011 requesting member states to submit information on initiatives and good practices in the area of the prevention of corruption, please be informed that the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany will shortly issue a high-quality e-learning programme to the Federal institutions for the use of public officials. The programme includes six modules which, by means of case studies and answers to pertinent questions, inform and sensitize a broad range of addressees (colleagues in positions with high corruption risk / team leaders / staff in general).

Another initiative within the Federal Ministry of the Interior has been the installation of an ombudsman on corruption-related matters as part of a pilot project.
