## Objectives

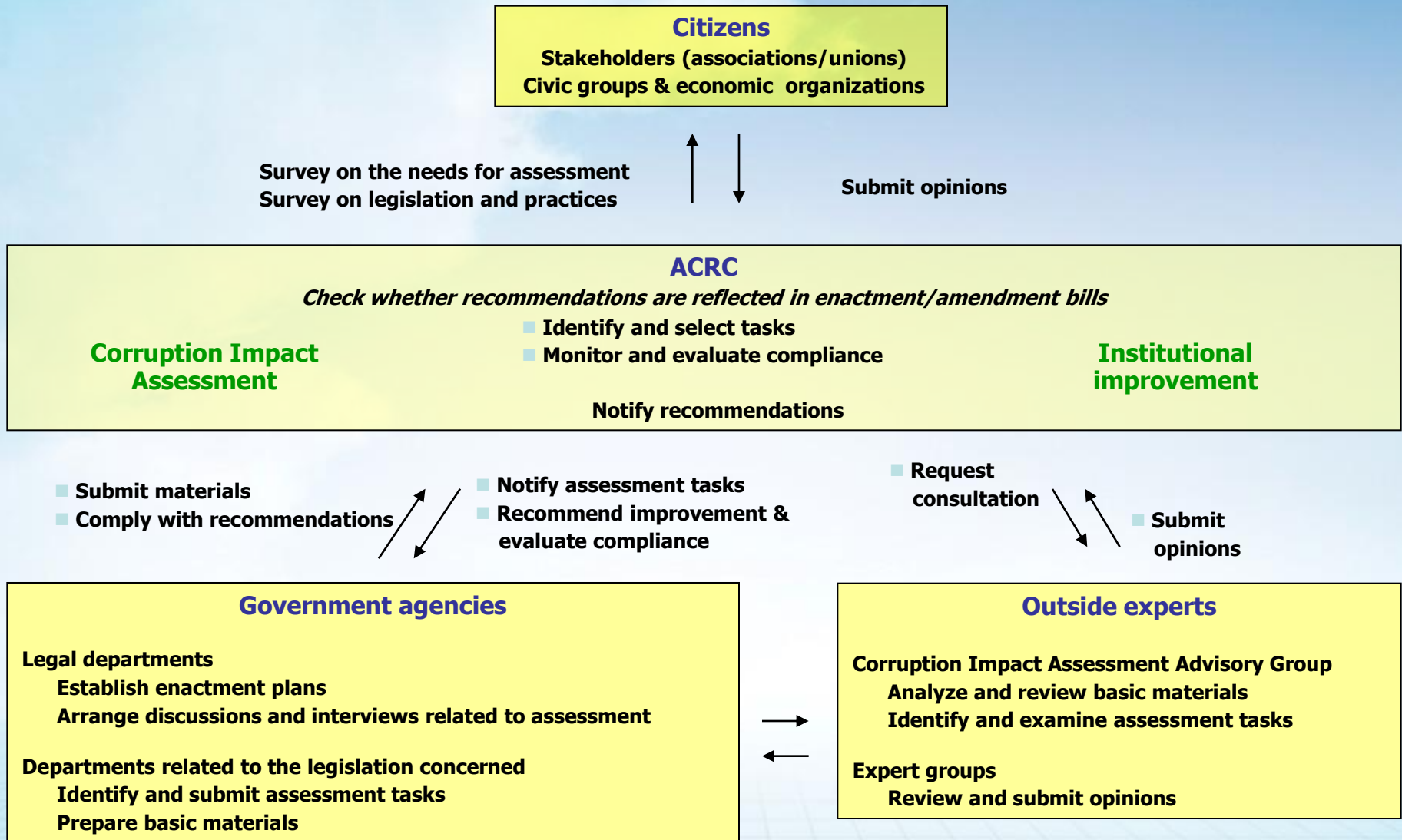
- Identify factors causing corruption in **bills and proposed amendments** as well as existing legislation
  - ⇒ Remove corruption risks **from the very stage of drafting laws and regulations**

## Legal basis

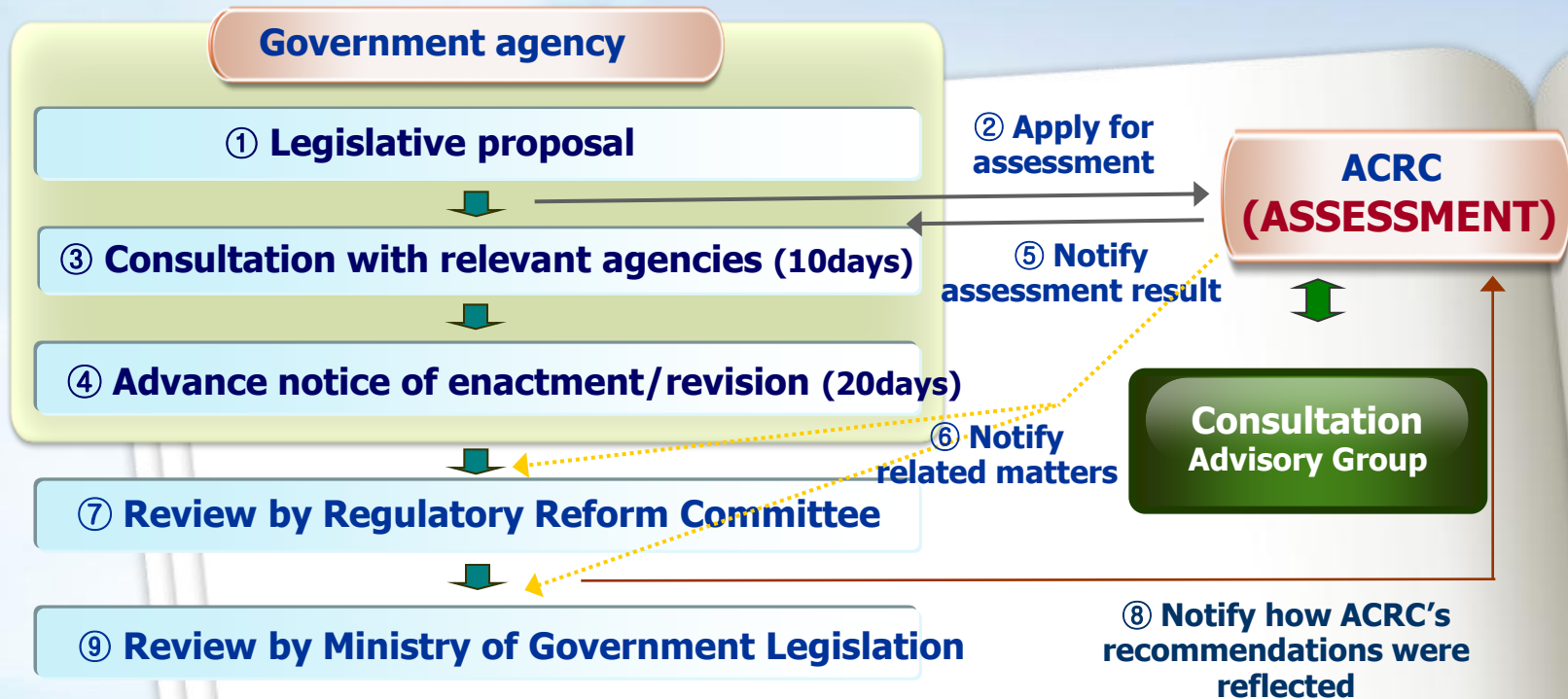
- Article 28.1 of the Act on Anti-Corruption and the Establishment and Operation of the Anti-Corruption & Civil Rights Commission
  - ⇒ The **ACRC** assesses **all forms of legislation** ranging from acts, presidential decrees, ordinances, directives, regulations, public notifications & administrative rules.

## Assessment factors and criteria

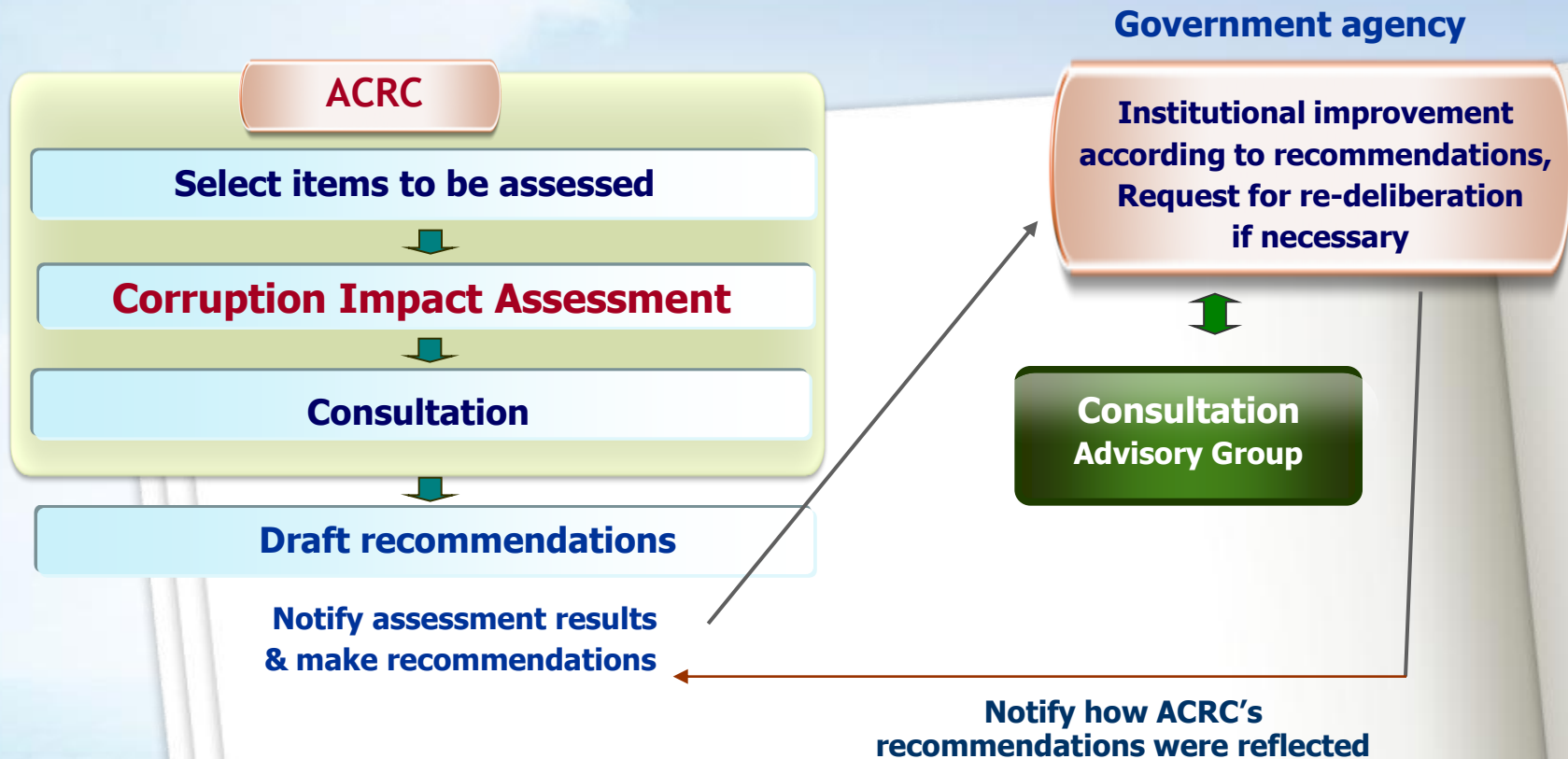
Factors	Criteria
<b>Ease of compliance</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Adequacy of the burden of compliance</li><li>• Adequacy of the level of sanctions</li><li>• Possibility of preferential treatment</li></ul>
<b>Appropriateness of execution standards</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Concreteness and objectiveness of discretionary regulations</li><li>• Appropriateness of consignment/entrustment standards</li><li>• Clarity of financial support standards</li></ul>
<b>Transparency of administrative procedure</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Accessibility and openness</li><li>• Predictability</li><li>• Possibility of a conflict of interest</li></ul>

## Corruption Impact Assessment for **proposed** legislation

- **Assessments completed**

<b>Bills received</b>	<b>Assessments completed</b>	
	<b>Agreed to original bill</b>	<b>Recommended amendments</b>
<b>1,368 (100%)</b>	<b>1,099 (80.0%)</b>	<b>269 (20.0%)</b>

## Corruption Impact Assessment for **proposed** legislation

- Recommended amendments by criteria  
(269 bills, 496 cases)

<b>Factors</b>	<b>Cases</b>
<b>Ease of compliance</b>	<b>100 cases (20%)</b>
<b>Propriety of discretion</b>	<b>263 cases (53%)</b>
<b>Transparency of administrative procedure</b>	<b>133 cases, 27%</b>
