2. Other content Compranet 5.0

- Permanent and updated availability of a compendium of documents and videos for the operation by public officials and bidders.

The American Company Gartner, is recognized as one of the leading worldwide in the research and analysis for the Information of Technologies Industries, in 2015 placed, for the third consecutive time, the system strategic developed by BravoSolution company, the same in which Compranet is operated since June of 2010, as one of the four world leader due to safety, execution capacity and development.

3. Magnitude of use and exploitation of Compranet 5.0

- ✓ 4,943 Purchasing units registered of the three levels of government (federal, states and municipalities).
- ✓ 268 Federal Government Institutions.
- ✓ 2,597 Institutions of the state and municipal government (They use the Compranet system when the contracts, totally or partially, use federal resources)
- ✓ 14,840 Accredited operators of the three levels of government.
- ✓ 186,749 Companies that has been registered in Compranet with ability to participate through of electronic media.
- ✓ 804,034 Recruitment Procedures.
- ✓ 2.78 Billions pesos awarded (186 billions US dollars in Anglo-Saxon nomenclature and exchange rate of 14 pesos per dollar.

4. CompraNet promotes participation and competition

- ✓ One of each three enterprises with new register in CompraNet, is awarded at least with one contract during its first year
- ✓ The average of proposals submitted in public tenders has increased (2011 = 3.0 2015 = 5.51).
- ✓ The average deserts procedures has been reduced (2011 = 8% 2015 = 5.8%).
- ✓ The trend of daily visits to the CompraNet portal has been on the raise (2011 = 22.6 mil 2015 = 39.8 mil).

5. Compranet is Strengthened

- In order to ensure continuous availability in the system operation, to raise the security conditions of the information in the database, as well as improve the speed of internet browsing users, from January 13, 2015 a new scheme of technical support was implemented, that guarantees:
 - ✓ Availability of 99.5% of the platform in which Compranet is supported.
 - ✓ Optimizing response times of searchers recruitment procedures available to the public, and
 - ✓ Early diagnostic of any failure or problema identified through permanent monitoring.
