




National Attitude in the Field of Preventing Human Trafficking Crimes: "Prevention" and "Combatting".





ACA's Experience in Fighting Corruption in the context of Human Trafficking.






In relation to what has been stated in the 27th element of the Basic Information Paper, prepared by the Secretary, entitled "Corruption in cases of Trafficking in Persons to Resect their Organs", ACA's Experience in fighting against this crime, particularly the resection of Kidney, has led to the following results:

Several crimes have been arrested and analyzed to understand how these criminal groups work and the gaps they exploit to commit their crimes.

Criminal Groups depend on the ignorance of medical staff, physicians and medical center of the consequences of this crime and the legal accountability.

There is a closed circle consisting of five basic elements for committing these crimes: donor, receiver, medical staff, medical centers, and medical laboratories.


