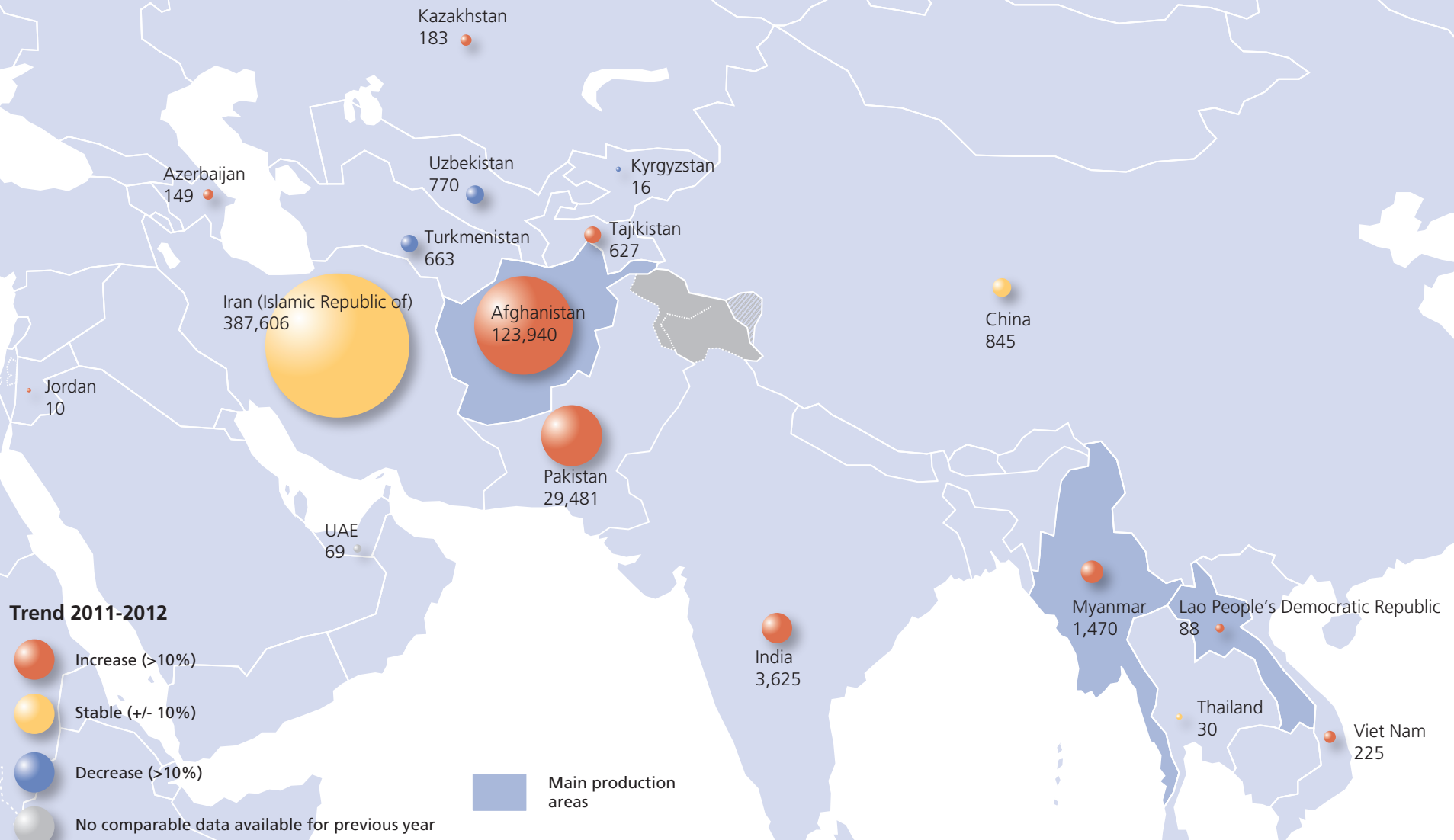


Opium seizures in Asia, 2012

The present map includes data from countries and territories for which official seizure data are available and amount to more than 10 kg.

The final status of Jammu and Kashmir has not yet been agreed upon by the parties.

The final boundary between the Republic of Sudan and the Republic of South Sudan has not yet been determined.

* The vast majority of seizures of opium are reported to UNODC by weight. Whenever the availability of information allows, seizures expressed in other units are converted to weight; in particular 1 litre is assumed to have a weight of 1kg.
