From Saturday, 9 December 2006 p.m. passes will be issued at the press registration counter at the King Hussein Bin Talal Convention Center upon presentation of two forms of photo ID (passport, official national press pass, drivers license, work ID, etc.)

Journalists who do not pre-register can also apply for accreditation on arrival at the press registration counter from 9 December 2006 p.m. onwards. They will need to bring a letter of assignment and a valid press card along with two forms of photo ID.
