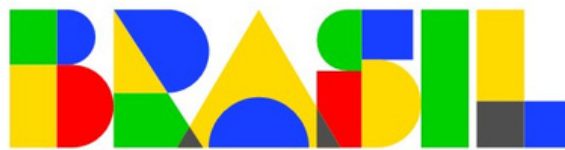
At this mid-way point through the Agenda 2030, bold and ambitious national governments call for an acceleration in the implementation of fair and child-friendly justice systems.
