

Ivo Škrobák is Head of Centre for Seized Assets at the Ministry of the Interior of the Czech Republic. He is author of new Conception of Seized Asset Management that Centre for Seized Assets implements in practise. He co-authored book: Practical Commentary on Act No. 279/2003 Coll., on the execution of seizure of property and goods in criminal proceedings. He lectures seized asset management at Czech Judicial Academy and the Police Academy of the Czech Republic.

His recent activities include creating system of preparation of seizure involving asset management office, improved communication between law enforcement and asset management office, regular decision making by law enforcement related to sales of movable assets resulting in improved efficiency of asset management.

Mr. Škrobák collaborates with European Commission Home Affairs platform related to Seized Assets Management established for exchange of knowledge and experience between member states. He is Secretary of Criminal Assets Management and Enforcement Regulators Association (CAMERA) which aim is to assist asset managers to maximize expertise as crime fighting tool.
