Situation in the Netherlands

International waste transports:

EU Waste Shipment Regulation 1013/2006 (WSR)

Competent Authority:

Minister of Infrastructure and Watermanagement

Notifications:

Human Environment and Transport Inspectorate (ILT) <u>Division: Permitting waste shipments</u>

Supervision:

Human Environment and Transport Inspectorate (ILT) <u>Division: Enforcement shipments of waste</u>





Some figures

Notifications per year

2.500 for import and export

1.200 for transit

Transport notifications

nearly 300.000

Shipments of green listed waste (non- hazardous)

minimum 1,5 mio?

Inspections

approx 3.500





Cooperation Enforcement Network

The ILT Inspectorate works closely with:

- Customs
- Police
- Port authorities
- Regional authorities

Inspections in the ports (with customs)
Inspections on the highways.



Agreement (MOU) with Customs

- Agreements for cooperation (information exchange, capacity, number of inspections/year, method of enforcement, specific controls)
- Enforcement instructions by ILT (criteria, priorities)
- VGEM team (team of waste experts)
- Customs makes each year an enforcement plan
- Each year feedback of enforcement results
- Agreements on the number of inspections and priorities (4000)



Cooperation in practice

Total 13 inspectors for international waste transports enforcement

Meeting at strategic, tactical, operational level

Exchange of knowledge and experiences

Support Education and training, guidance, manuals etc.

Assistance in the development of Customs profiles

Criminal and administrative law enforcement





training and role of experts

- Every custom and police officer is trained (basics) on environmental laws
- Experts on TFS within Customs and Police
- Role of experts:
 - training colleagues
 - support in profiling
 - first contact for frontline officers
 - contactperson for env auth
 - coordinator/support inspections/operations
 - etc.





Most of the waste shipments are intra-EU

Waste exports are mainly destined for:

Turkey including metal scrap, ships, rubber (tyres) and plastics

Africa including e-waste, cars and tyres declared as 2nd hand goods

Asia including waste paper, metal scrap, waste plastics, rubber/tyres



Modus Operandi illegal shipments of waste

- Concealment
 - Hidden (hazardous) waste
- Misdeclared
 - Product vs waste, including 2nd hand goods, by-products and end of waste
 - Non hazardous vs hazardous waste
 - Due to stricter controls or ban for certain destinations








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Declared waste paper

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New trend: End of waste

- In the EU waste can reach the 'end of waste status' when:
- 1) the substance or object is to be used for specific purposes;
- 2) a market or demand exists for such a substance or object;
- 3) the substance or object fulfils the technical requirements for the specific purposes and meets the existing legislation and standards applicable to products; and
- 4) the use of the substance or object will not lead to overall adverse environmental or human health impacts.



New trend: End of waste

- EU Regulations in place for end of waste:
 - Iron, steel and aluminium scrap
 - Copper scrap
 - Glass cullets

All other waste streams often 'case-by-case' approach



New EU Waste Shipment Regulation

- Expected to enter into force spring 2024
- Amongst others, changes for <u>export EU- non-OECD</u>
- Including:
 - Exportban for hazardous waste and for Y46, Y47, Y48, (Y49?)
 - Exportban for waste prohibitited by country of destination
 - Exportban for mixtures of hazardous waste and mixtures of hazardous and non-hazardous waste
 - Exportban for waste which is considered as hazardous waste by country of destination (art 3 BC).



New EU Waste Shipment Regulation

- For plastic waste (B3011) prohibition starting 2,5 years after the new WSR has entered into force
- After five years export of B3011 possible to EU authorised countries and facilities which are on an EU list
- Other non-hazardous waste (paper, metals, etc.):
- Three years after the new WSR entered into force export to authorised countries and facilities which are on an EU list.
- Untill the new WSR will enter into force the old one applies



Expectations

- More waste will be exported as 'end of waste' or by-product
- Questions:
 - Does the end of waste status also means that the material can be imported as 'product' instead of waste?
 - Will the exporting country be able to stop the export of 'end of waste' when the importing country refuses the import?
 - Is it possible for the importing state to repatriate the material when they considerit as waste but it was end of waste in the EU?


