# WHY YOUTH EMPOWERMENT?

#### The empowerment of youth is a cross-cutting commitment of UNODC.

- Building off key commitments of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, the Youth 2030 Strategy, the UNODC Strategy 2021-2025 as well as Our Common Agenda.
- Youth Empowerment involves:
  - Working "with", not just "for" young people;
  - Youth involvement in every step of the programme cycle;
  - Focus on involving young people in decision-making processes.
- Internal partnerships, as well as cooperation with external partners such as CSOs, academia, the private sector and regional organizations, are key to advancing youth empowerment.




# YOUTH EMPOWERMENT ACCELERATOR (YEA!) FRAMEWORK

- Affirms UNODC's commitment to empowering youth as part of the UNODC Strategy 2021-2025.
- The Strategic Planning and Inter-Agency
   Affairs Unit (SPIA) acts as the focal point for
   youth mainstreaming actions.
- At UNODC, "youth" is more broadly defined as individuals between the ages of 15 and 29.







Addressing and Countering the World Drug Problem



#### **Addressing and Countering the World Drug Problem**

- Increase coverage and quality of prevention, treatment, care and rehabilitation by promoting evidence-based services in line with UNODC/WHO International Standards.
- Intensify focus on vulnerable populations (including children, youth, women and people in contact with the criminal justice system and in humanitarian settings).

#### **Cross-Cutting Commitments**

 Support meaningful participation and empowerment of children and youth as well as their protection





## YOUTH INITIATIVE

- Launched in 2012, and celebrating its decade!
- For youth to share their experiences, ideas and creativity, and to get support for creating their own substance use prevention and health promotion activities.











### UNODC Youth Forum

- Annual event organized in the broader context of the Commission on Narcotic Drugs (CND).
- Gather young people active in drug use prevention, health promotion to '<u>Educate</u>', '<u>Engage</u>', and '<u>Empower</u>' to better protect the health of their peers.











### DAPC Grants

 Drug Abuse Prevention Center (DAPC) of Japan raises funds and donates to UNODC to support youth-centered activities aimed to prevent drug use in low- and middle- income countries



 Youth volunteers raise funds to support youth drug prevention NGO projects.

 Implement youth-centered activities to prevent drug use in schools and communities.










Mission: Create a culture of rejection of corruption among children and youth by harnessing the transformational power of education and partnerships.






#### GLOBAL INITIATIVE ON YOUTH CRIME PREVENTION THROUGH **SPORT**
