Section 4 - On terrorism

Article 314 - Terrorist acts mean all acts that aim to create a state of panic and are committed by means such as explosive devices, inflammable materials, poisonous or incendiary products, and epidemic or microbial agents that may cause a general danger.

Article 315 (1) - Conspiracies intended to commit an act or acts of terrorism is punishable by temporary hard labor.

Every terrorist act requires hard labor for at least five years.

It requires permanent hard labor if it results in sabotage, even partially, in a public building, industrial establishment, ship, or other establishments, or disrupting the means of communication, transport, and transportation.

The death penalty shall be imposed if the act results in the death of a person or destroys part or all of structure in which one or more people were inside of it at the time.

Article 316 - Every association established with the intention of changing the economic or social entity of the state, or the basic conditions of society, by one of the means mentioned in Article 314, shall be dissolved and its members are sentenced with temporary hard labor.

The penalty for the founders and directors shall not be less than seven years.

The excuse given to the conspirators under Article 272 includes the perpetrators of the felony specified above.

Article 316 bis - added according to Law No. 553 dated 20/10/2003 and amended by Law No. 77 of dated 27/10/2016.

Financing Terrorism

Anyone who intentionally directs or participates in any means, directly or indirectly, finances in whole or in part or contributes to the financing of terrorism or terrorist acts, or the financing of a terrorist person or a terrorist organizations, or the acts associated with them, including offering or providing or collecting movable or immovable money, from legal or illegal sources, in Lebanon or abroad,

whether or not the money was used, and whether or not the terrorist act took place in Lebanon or abroad.

The crime of financing terrorism includes travel, attempted travel, recruitment, planning, preparation, organization, facilitation, participation, providing or receiving training, and any other act associated with it with the intention to carry out terrorist acts and without those acts being linked to a specific terrorist act.

The perpetrators of the acts specified above shall be punished with temporary hard labor for a period of no less than three years and not exceeding seven years, and a fine of not less than the amount paid and not exceeding three times the amount paid, and this does not preclude the application of the penalties stipulated in Articles 212 to 222 inclusive of the Penal Code.
