

Job 21-00486 (communication from Spain on implementation of Nuclear Terrorism Convention – fair copy)

*Translated from Spanish*

With reference to the letter dated 30 September 2020 from the Terrorism Prevention Branch of your Office, I am pleased to inform you that Spanish legislation regulates terrorist offences in general terms under title XXII, chapter VII, of volume II of the Spanish Criminal Code, as follows:

- Terrorist organizations and groups (section 1, arts. 571 and 572)
- Terrorist offences (section 2, arts. 573 to 580 bis)

In addition, Spain has ratified the International Convention for the Suppression of Acts of Nuclear Terrorism, adopted in New York on 13 April 2005. The Convention was published in Official Gazette No. 146 on 19 June 2007.
