

Job 21-03498 (communication from Tunisia regarding implementation of the International Convention for the Suppression of Acts of Nuclear Terrorism – fair copy)

With reference to the request from the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime in Vienna to provide it with information on national legislation related to the suppression of acts of nuclear terrorism in the context of seeking support for its efforts to universalize and effectively implement the International Convention for the Suppression of Acts of Nuclear Terrorism, I have the honour to inform you of the following relevant national legislation:

- Organic Law No. 26 of 2015 (dated 7 August 2015) concerning the combating of terrorism and suppression of money-laundering, as amended by Organic Law No. 9 of 2019 (23 January 2019)
- Government Order No. 419 of 2019 (dated 17 May 2019) regulating procedures for the implementation of resolutions adopted by relevant United Nations bodies to suppress the financing of terrorism and financing of the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction, as amended by Government Order No. 457 of 2019 (dated 31 May 2019)
- Government Order No. 524 of 2019 (dated 17 June 2019) amending Government Order No. 1777 of 2015 (dated 25 November 2015) regulating the National Counter-Terrorism Committee and its methods of operation, including the establishment of the core unit of the Permanent Secretariat of the National Counter-Terrorism Committee, which is concerned with implementing United Nations resolutions to suppress the financing of terrorism and financing of the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction
